



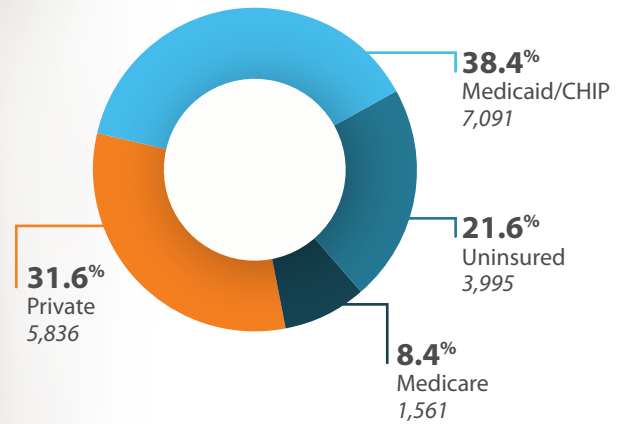

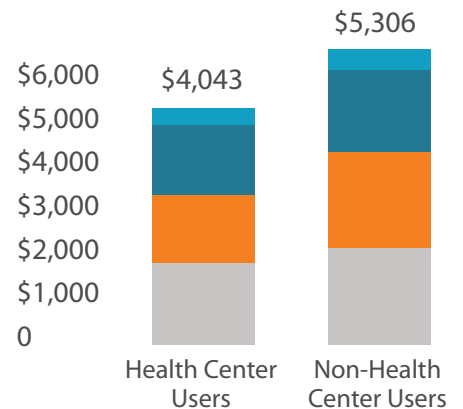
CDCHC has seen a 0.6% increase in the number of total patients since 2010.

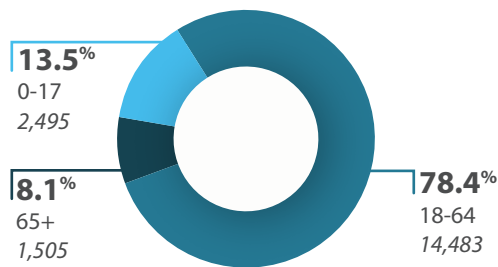

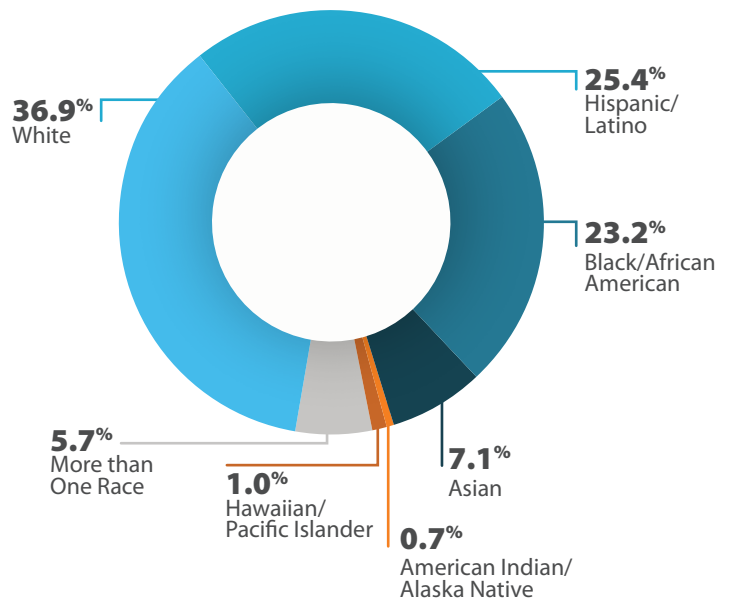

Who We Serve CDCHC serves all patients, regardless of their ability to pay.

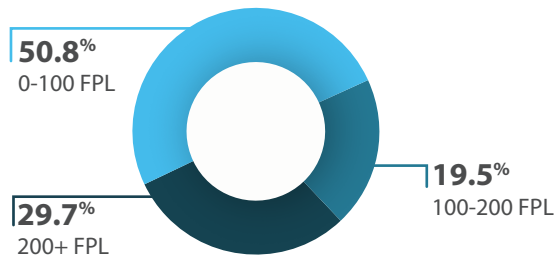
Patients by Age



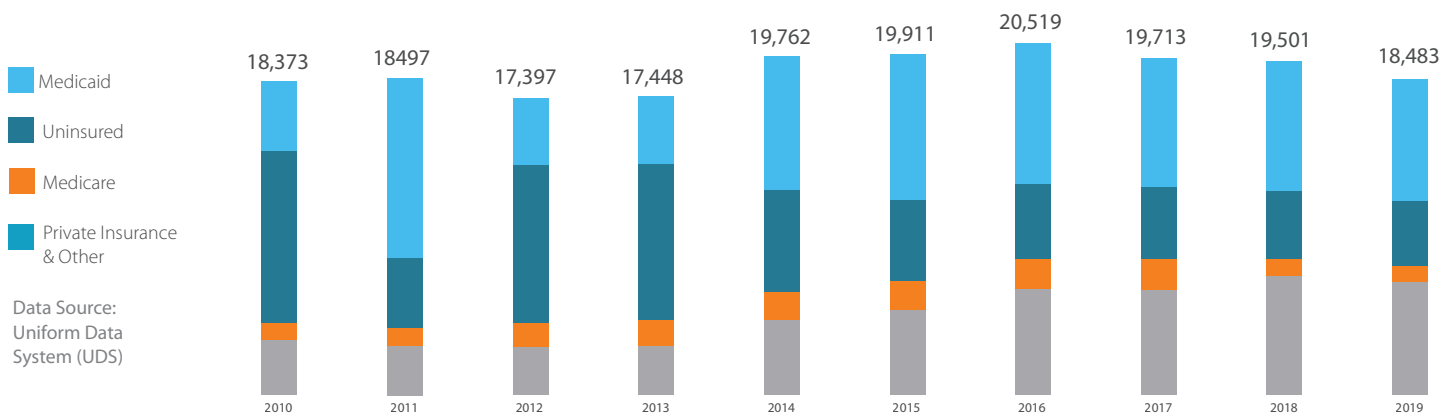
Patients by Race/Ethnicity
