

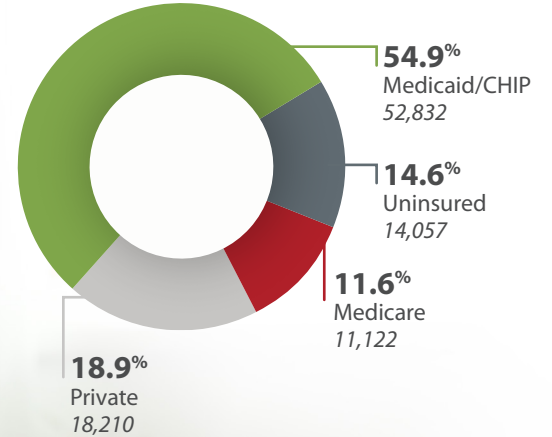

### Essential

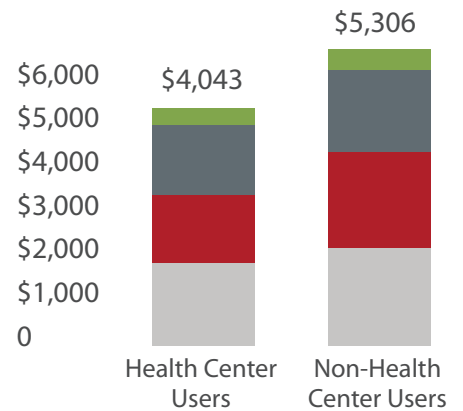
CHAS has seen a 178.97% increase in the number of total patients since 2010.
