

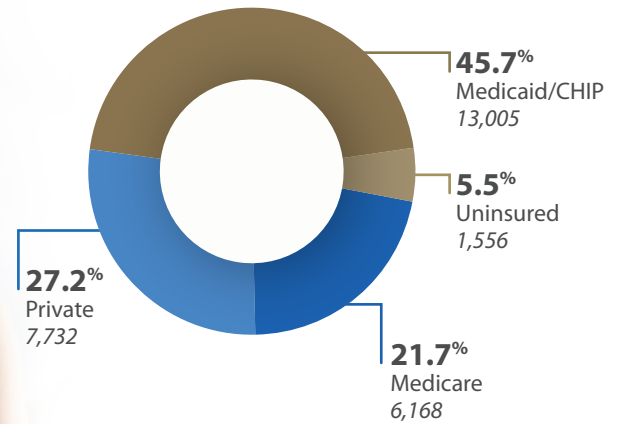

### Essential

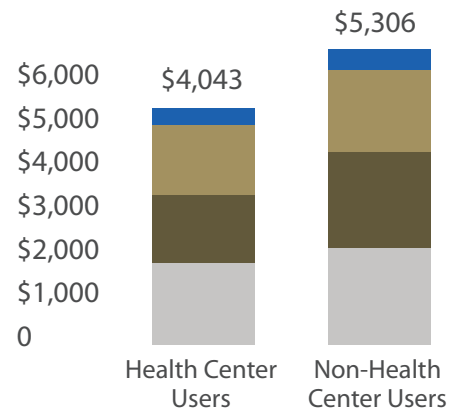
CHCW has seen a **524.97% increase** in the number of total patients since 2010.

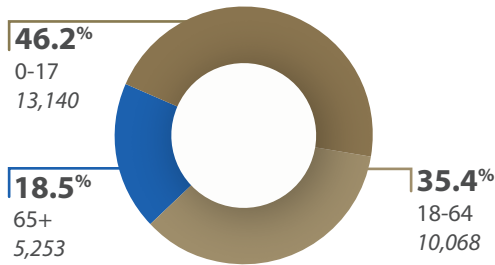

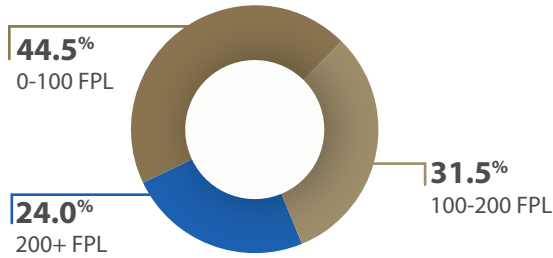
# Who We Serve

CHCW serves all patients, regardless of their ability to pay.

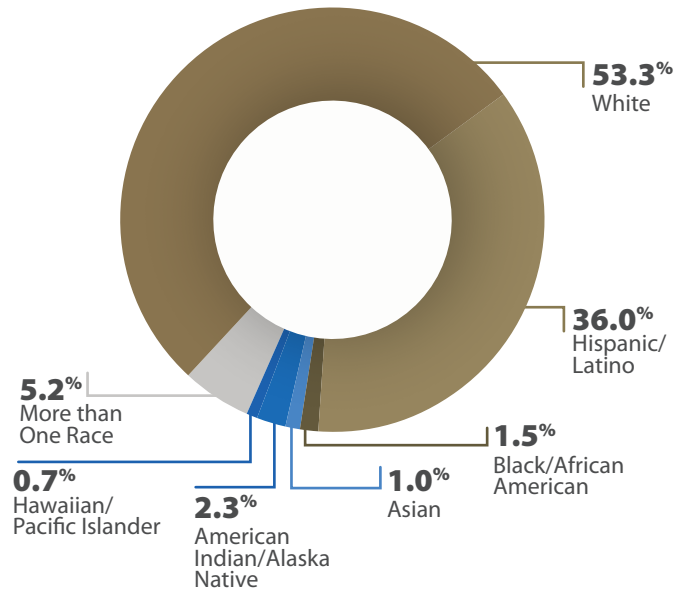
## Patients by Age



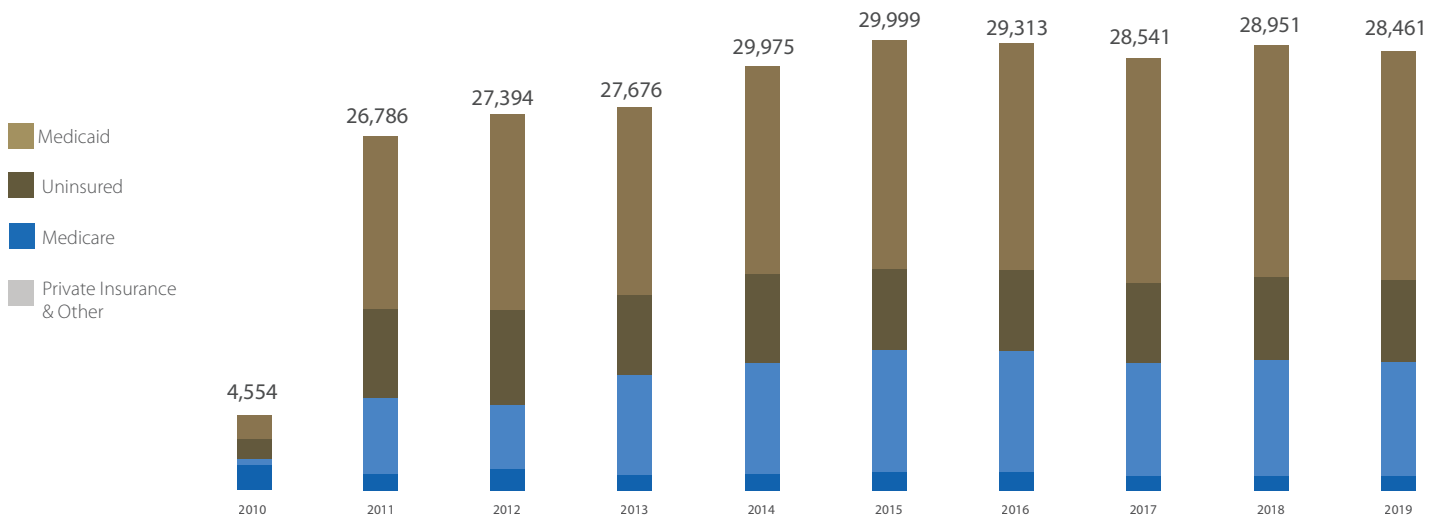
## Patients by Income Level
