

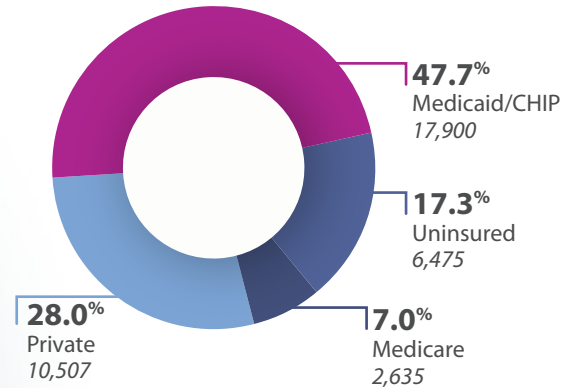

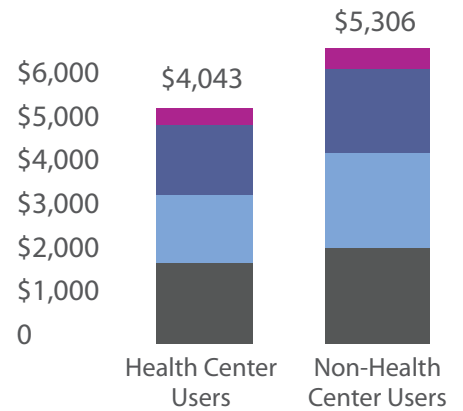
CVCH has seen a 73.47% increase in the number of total patients since 2010.

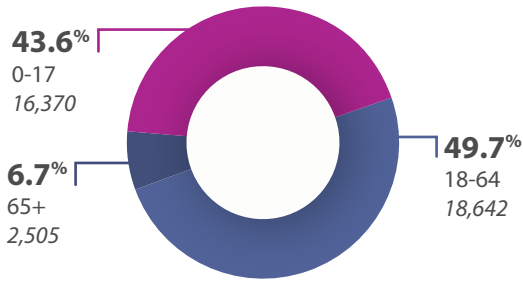

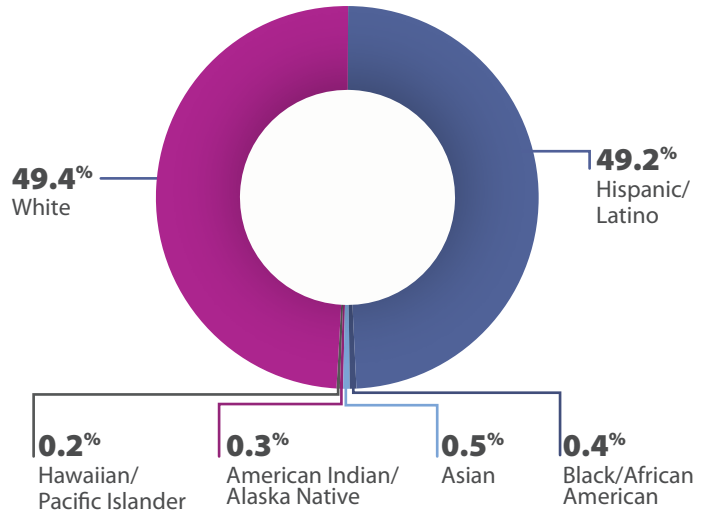

Who We Serve CVCH serves all patients, regardless of their ability to pay.

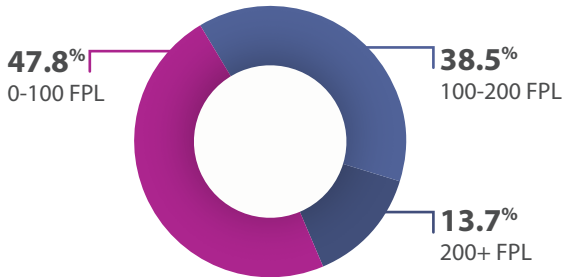
Patients by Age



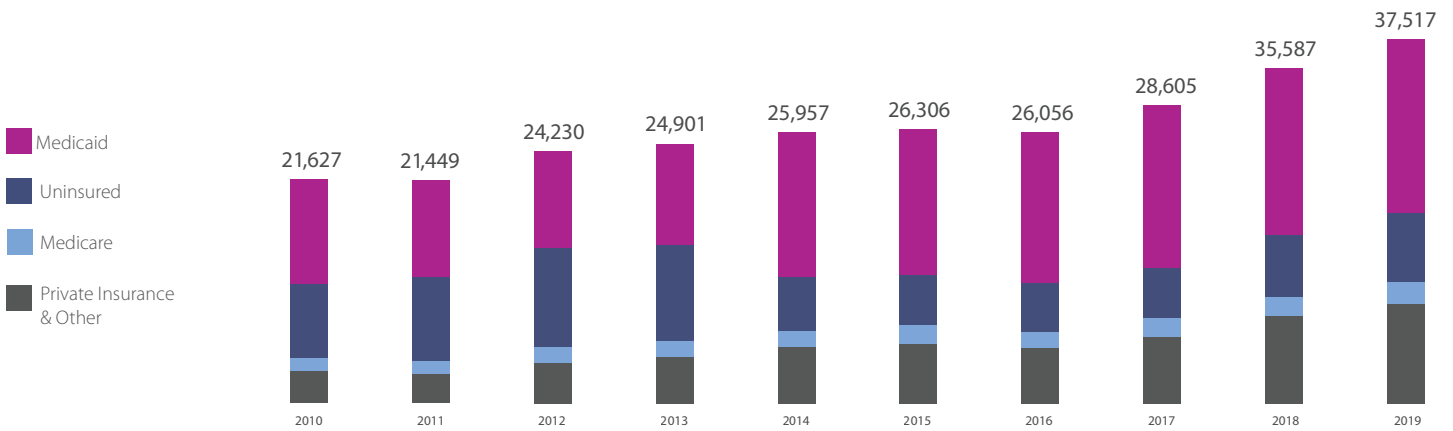
Patients by Race/Ethnicity
